#### Special Session

Public Hearing City Tax Property Tax Levy. SUBJECT: March 2, 2020 AS THE DATE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO ADOPT A MAXIMUM CITY PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020/21

BACKGROUND: During the 2019 legislative session, changes were made to the Iowa Code that altered the process for adoption of annual budgets for cities. Per Iowa Code Section 384.15A, cities must now hold a public hearing and adopt a maximum property tax levy in any year the city expects to adopt a budget that includes a levy of property taxes (excluding debt service) exceeding 102 percent of the prior budget. Additionally, the Code requires that notice of the hearing be included on the City internet site and primary social media account. The approval of the maximum levy requires a two-thirds majority of the Council. One of stated purposes of the new legislation was to improve transparency and disclosure of proposed property tax increases for local government.

Resolution #03022020 Resolution approving the maximum levy amount of \$219,100 Councilwoman Carmella Jones made a motion to accept the resolution approving Resolution #03022020, David Wilcox seconded and a roll call vote was taken.
